Catarratto IGT Terre Siciliane 2019

Bright pale yellow. With notes of white peach, pear and broom, medium bodied on the palate with herbal notes that blend very well with a pleasant mineral finish.

VINEYARDS

Vineyards grow in Chirchiaro, between Salemi and Vita at 500 a.s.l.. The medium texture limestone-siliceous soil together with a good thermal range, ensure ideal conditions to enhance the characteristic of the varieties. Vines are planted facing East using the trellis system, and guyot pruning.

HARVEST 2018

Mild temperatures together with late summer rain, guaranteed enough humidity to the soil and a late but good development of all the phenological phases and this brought to a strong development of primary aromas.

WINE MAKING

Hand-picked September 29th. De stemming and skin maceration for a few hours, and soft-pressed before fermentation at 15°C in stainless-steel tanks. The wine is then left on its lees for a 50 days before being bottled.

Varietal: Catarratto

Vineyard: Chirchiaro, Western Sicily

Colour: Pale yellow with green hints

Nose: Papaya, white peach, broom and lemon

Palate: Medium structure, stone fruits, mineral notes and pleasant acidity

Pairing: Great with sea food, fish pasta dishes or vegetarian risottos

Serving Temperature: 8-10 C°

Closure: Diam 5

Harvest: September 29th
